Photography Policy & Conduct Guidance

1. Purpose

The Reche Canyon Naturist Association (RCNA) is committed to protecting **privacy, consent, and personal dignity** at all RCNA-sponsored activities and events.

This document provides:

1. The official RCNA **Photography Policy**, reproduced verbatim from RCNA governing documents; and
2. **Photography conduct guidance** to help members and participants understand how the policy is applied in practice.

This document is provided for **informational and reference purposes** and does **not** create new policy.

2. Governing Authority & Source Reference

This Photography Policy is issued pursuant to and derived from the following RCNA governing document:

This policy is administered by the **RCNA Board of Directors** in accordance with the RCNA Bylaws and Policies & Procedures Manual.

Photography as deemed appropriate by the board for each event.

This is the complete and controlling photography policy as adopted by the RCNA Board of Directors.

4. Photography Conduct & Awareness Guidance

(Informational – Does Not Replace Policy)

The following guidance is provided to help members understand how the RCNA Photography Policy is applied in practice. This guidance does **not** modify or supersede governing policy and remains subject to Board authority.

Members should be aware that:

- Photography is **not presumed** to be permitted at RCNA events
- Any photography permissions are **event-specific** and determined by the RCNA Board of Directors
- Photography rules or permissions will be communicated by RCNA leadership or event organizers when applicable

Members are expected to observe the following conduct standards:

- **Individual consent is required** before photographing or recording any person
- Photography is prohibited in **private, sensitive, or restricted areas**
- Images may **not be shared, posted, tagged, or distributed** without explicit consent from all identifiable individuals
- Members must comply with all instructions from RCNA leadership, event staff, or designated representatives regarding photography
- Failure to respect privacy or consent may result in corrective action in accordance with RCNA governing documents

5. Relationship to Other RCNA Policies

This document should be read in conjunction with the following RCNA policies:

- **RCNA Anti-Discrimination Policy**
- **RCNA Governing Documents**

All RCNA members, guests, and participants are expected to comply with these policies collectively.

6. Administrative Note

This document is maintained for transparency and member awareness.

Formal acknowledgment of photography policies and conduct expectations may be required as part of the RCNA membership application and onboarding process.
